Egg painting with blown eggs

Firstly, you need to blow out the inside of the egg. Ask an adult to put a pin hole in one end of the egg and then a slightly bigger pin hole in the other end. You can carefully blow through the small hole until all of the egg is in a cup (keep egg for cupcake recipe below). You now have a very delicate eggshell. Leave on the windowsill to dry out overnight.

Paint as you wish. You need to be very careful as these shells are eggtremely delicate!



Easter cupcakes

- 125g softened butter
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1 ¼ cups caster sugar
- 3 eggs
- 1 cup plain flour
- ½ cup self-raising flour
- 14 teaspoon baking soda
- ½ cup milk

Turn oven to 180 deg and line your cupcake tins.

Add all ingredients into a bowl and beat on medium speed for 1-2 min until the mixture is smooth and changed to a paler colour. Pour evenly into your paper cases and bake for 15-17 mins.

Once cool, ice and decorate.

To make the icing mix together 25g softened butter, 1 cup icing sugar, 1 tablespoon of cocoa and a little milk to mix.

The nest is lined with green coconut (simply mix coconut and green food dye together) and sprinkle on the icing when still wet. Top with bunny ears or Easter eggs.

We cut marshmallows in half with the scissors and dunked the sticky bits in jelly crystals for the bunny ears.

Notes,

Don't forget to use your blown egg.

If you'd rather make this a cake you need to cook it for one hour. You just need to grease your tin.

This makes the best birthday cake!
