Do you need to improve your typing or learn how to touch type?

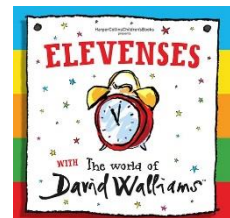
An awesome site to learn on is <https://www.typingclub.com/>

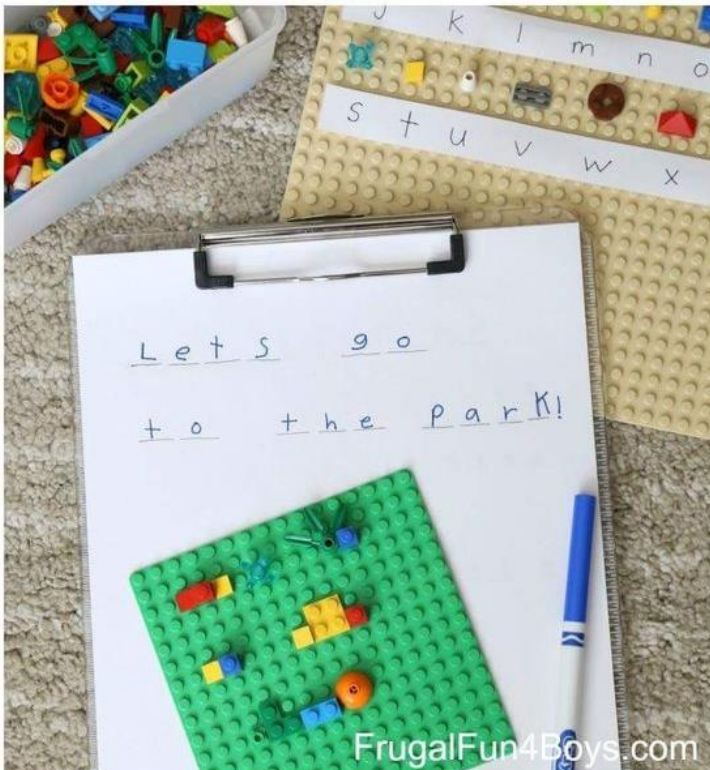
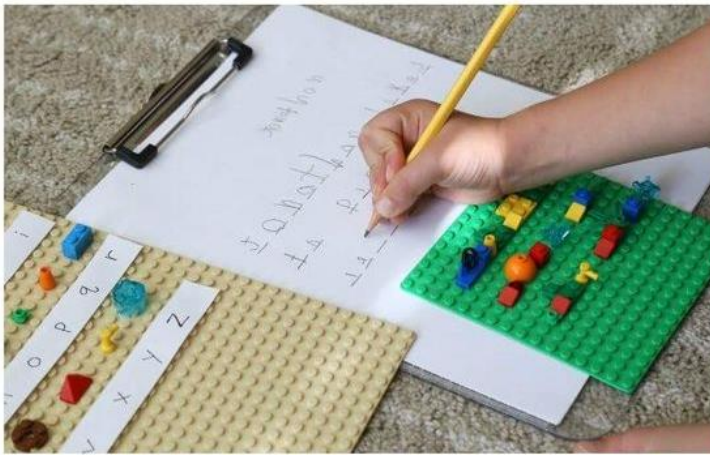
# LEGO Secret Codes

Can you make your own codes?

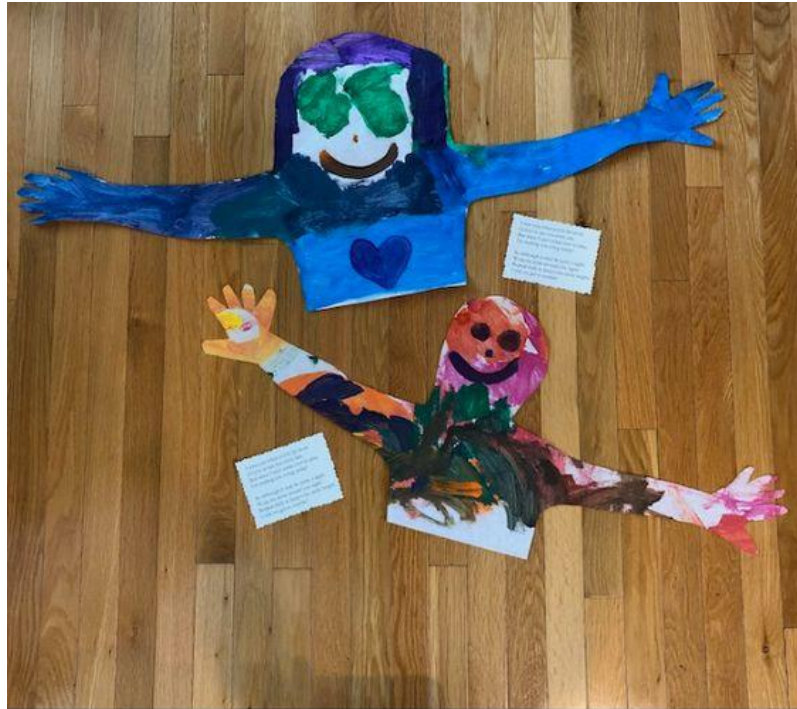
First you need to write out the alphabet. Leave gaps between each letter so you have room for the lego to be spaced above. Cut the page so the alphabet fits across your lego board.
